

TRANSFERRING WMA AUDIOBOOKS TO AN IPAD/IPOD

NOTE: This only works on Windows computers, it will not work on a Mac!

1. Start on the main WVDELI page. It's probably easiest to click the Advanced Search link under the Search box at the top right.



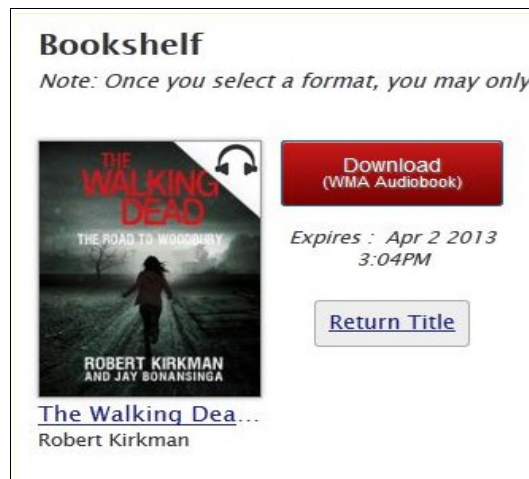
2. To see everything in WMA format, use these settings (format: WMA, only titles that are available now). You can add other filters if you wish.

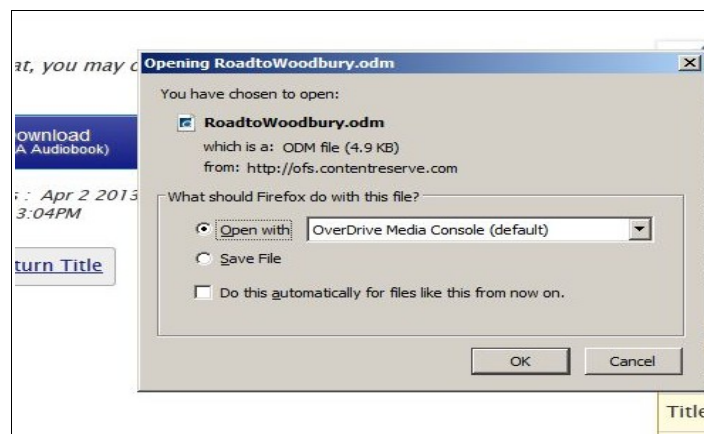
3. Click on the book cover for the title that you want.



4. On the next screen, you'll click BORROW, then see this screen that indicates the item is checked out to you. To download it you'll need to click the DOWNLOAD button. Please note that, at this point, you can still click RETURN to send the item back.



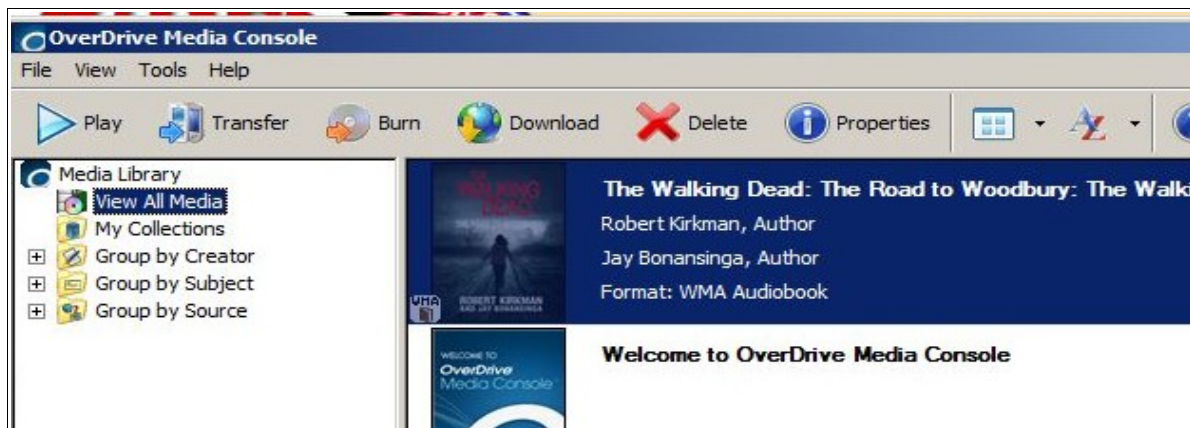
5. Make sure that it's set to open with Overdrive Media Console, then click OPEN.



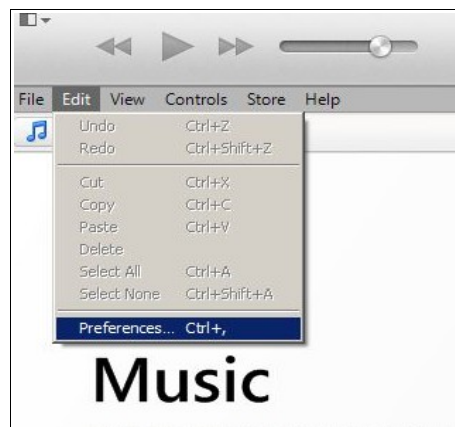
6. You'll see this popup in the Overdrive program. It's usually easiest to let the program put the files in the folder that it selects.



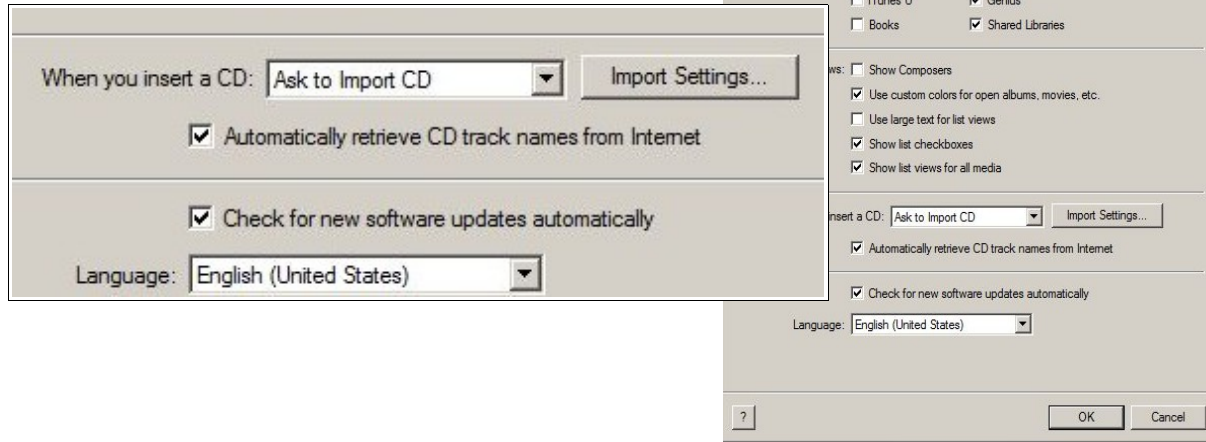
7. Once it's finished, you'll see it at the top of the Overdrive program. At this point, you can go ahead and connect your iPad or iPod.



8. When you connect your device, iTunes should open. Before you proceed, go to Edit, then Preferences.



9. Click on Import Settings in the "General" section.



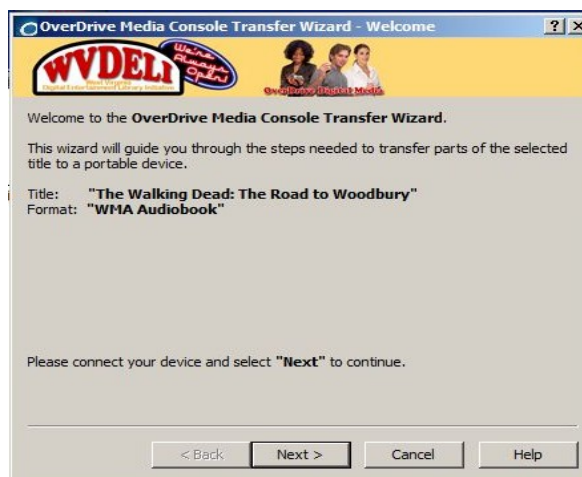
10. Please make sure that you're set on "Spoken Podcast".



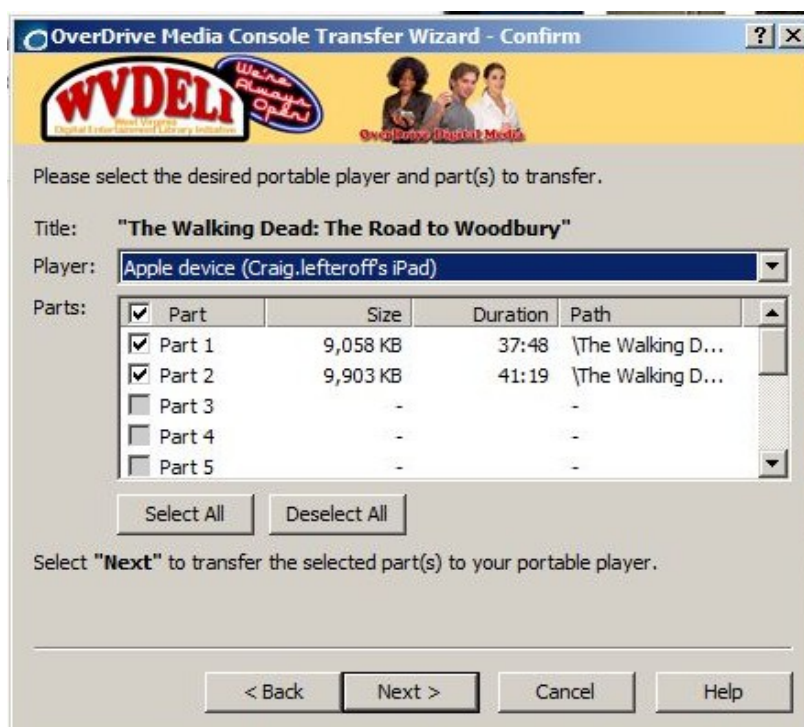
11. Now you can go back to Overdrive. Since you've connected your device, now click Transfer.



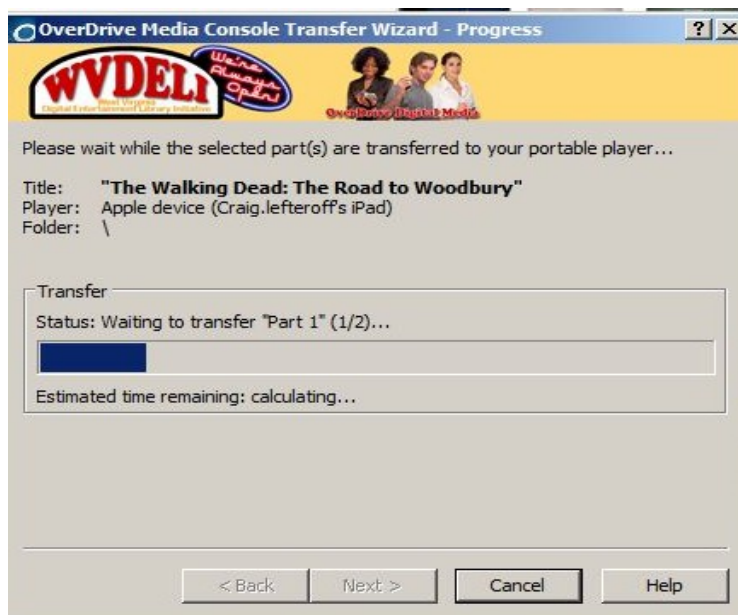
12. Click NEXT to proceed.



13. You should see something that looks like this. You can select all the parts of the book or just a part or two at a time if you don't feel like waiting. Click NEXT when you're done.



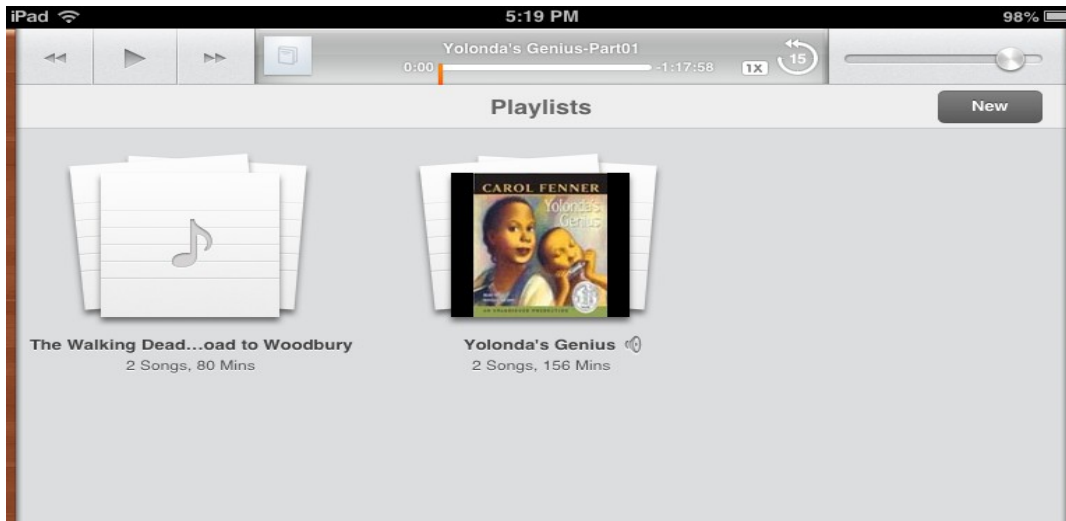
14. You'll see a status bar that displays your progress.



15. When it reaches this point, click FINISH and disconnect your device.



16. Your audiobook might be in the "Music" section on your device, in the "Playlists" area. It might or might not appear in the Overdrive Media Console app, depending on the kind of device that you have and the year in which it was manufactured.



IF YOU HAVE PROBLEMS

- Check your settings for manually managing music. Connect your device and, when iTunes starts, select your device from the upper right corner of the iTunes window.



Click "Manually Manage" under Options, then click Done.
