



Information About the Clendenin and Elk Valley Branch Libraries Updated 7/25/16

- Due to flood damage, the Clendenin Branch Library and Elk Valley Branch Library are closed until further notice.
- To provide services while there is no access to the Elk Valley Branch Library, KCPL will open the Elk Valley Express Library at the previous Elk Valley Branch location at 4636 Pennsylvania Avenue in Big Chimney on Tuesday, July 26. The library will have 8 public computers, free Wi-Fi and a limited inventory of materials for children, teens and adults, including books, audiobooks, DVDs, CDs, and Playaways, as well as Express DVDs and books. Patrons will also be able to use this location to pick up holds from other libraries in the KCPL system. The phone number for the temporary Elk Valley Express Library is 304-965-8956
- Elk Valley Express hours of operation July 26-July 30 will be Tuesday and Thursday, 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.; Wednesday and Friday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.; and Saturday, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Beginning Aug. 1, Elk Valley Express library hours will be Monday through Thursday, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Friday and Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- The Mobile Library has added an additional stop to the schedule and will now be at the site of the former Dairy Queen in Clendenin every Friday from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. Other Mobile Library stops can be found here <http://bit.ly/29ied74>.

- Please don't worry about returning any checked out KCPL items you have that were lost or damaged in the flood. If you have items that have not been damaged, you may return them to any KCPL location. Any items that were due May 1, 2016 or later at the Elk Valley or Clendenin Branches will now be due on **September 1, 2016** (this includes Express items).
- Any items that are currently on hold to be picked up at the Clendenin or Elk Valley Branches have been suspended. If you want to get a copy of a title you already had a hold on, please contact another KCPL location so staff can unsuspend your hold and select a different pickup library. Patrons may always place holds to be picked up at other KCPL locations.
- You may contact another KCPL location to request an interlibrary loan (ILL).
- If you are registered for any of the Summer Library Clubs at the Elk Valley or Clendenin Branches and want to turn in your materials, you may take them to any other KCPL location to receive your prize.

- Thank you to everyone who has offered to help. We appreciate the many offers to donate books and other materials, but at this time, we are not in a position to consider replacing the collection and we could not deal effectively with donations if they were received.
