



Information about the Clendenin and Elk Valley Branch Libraries Updated 6/19/17

- Due to flood damage, the Clendenin Branch Library and Elk Valley Branch Library are closed until further notice.
- To provide services while there is no access to the Elk Valley Branch Library, KCPL has opened the Elk Valley Express Library at the previous Elk Valley Branch location at 4636 Pennsylvania Avenue in Big Chimney. The library will have 8 public computers, free Wi-Fi and a limited inventory of materials for children, teens and adults, including books, audiobooks, DVDs, CDs, and Playaways, as well as Express DVDs and books. Patrons will also be able to use this location to pick up holds from other libraries in the KCPL system. The phone number for the temporary Elk Valley Express Library is 304-965-8956
- Elk Valley Express library hours are Monday through Thursday, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Friday and Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
