## **KCPL To Reopen After Extended Holiday Closure**

Kanawha County Public Library will reopen on Monday, January 11, 2021, offering curbside services throughout the library system. Although buildings will remain closed to the public until February 28<sup>th</sup>, all locations will offer KCPL curbside service starting January 11<sup>th</sup>, except for the Main Branch location at the Charleston Town Center. The Town Center branch will provide special limited services at its location on level two, near Talbot's. Patrons will be able to pick up reserved items at the location but will not be permitted to enter or browse.

KCPL curbside service allows patrons to contact their local branch to reserve books, movies, and other materials. Patrons are then able to arrange a time to pick up the requested items without having to enter the building. The shift to curbside service during January and February is being made to ensure the safety of patrons and staff due to COVID-19 concerns in the aftermath of the holiday season.
