KCPL Mobile Library to Provide Curbside Service

Kanawha County Public Library is expanding its curbside service with the help of the Mobile Library. Beginning Wednesday, January 20, the Mobile Library will provide curbside service for the Main Library. It will perform similar services that are currently available at the branches, such as picking up library materials and returning items.

The Mobile Library will be available at the Patrick Street Plaza on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. Patrons may request items or holds from the KCPL website (www.kanawhalibrary.org) or by calling the Main Library at (304) 343-4646. Those items will then be sent to the Mobile Library to be picked up at the Patrick Street Plaza. The Mobile Library, however, will not be able to handle fines or process new library cards. KCPL continues serving the community through its special limited services during the COVID pandemic.
